For the sake of this document:

- All First Tee Jr. Tour representatives on-site and involved in First Tee Jr. Tour are referred to as "Coaches", whether they are full-time staff, part-time staff, adult volunteers or interns.
- All First Tee Jr. Tour participants engaged in tournament play are referred to as "Players".

AGE DIVISIONS | 9 HOLE & 18 HOLE TOURNAMENTS: (*FTJT reserves the right to adjust age divisions once the playing rosters are completed)

• Nine (9) Hole Tournaments – Ages 12 – 18 – (Walk with bag/pull cart)

BOYS: * Age Divisions: 12 – 18 GIRLS: * Age Divisions: 12 – 18

Eighteen (18) Hole Tournaments – Ages 16 – 18 – (Walk with bag/pull cart)

BOYS & GIRLS: *

Age Divisions: 12 – 18

- Tee Times On Tuesday of tournament week you will be sent, via email, your assigned Tee Time.
- You may not exchange Tee Times with another Player.
- Arrive at the golf course no more than one (1) hour prior to your Tee Time.
- You will have 30 minutes on the driving range and then will be asked to either go to putting green or short game area before arriving at the 1st Tee.
- You will not be allowed to enter the Golf Pro Shop or Clubhouse dining room. Please be sure you have all golf supplies before arriving at the golf course (tees, pencil, golf gloves, golf balls etc.)
- Your score card will be handed to you on the 1st Tee box.
- Players should report to the 1st Tee at least ten (10) minutes prior to your Tee Time (only Players are allowed at the tee, putting green, chipping, locker rooms). If you are late for your scheduled Tee Time, you will not be allowed to play that day and no refund will be given to you.
- Parents/Guardians are required to stay in their vehicle if they choose to stay on property throughout the tournament. Spectators/parents are not allowed inside the clubhouse, pool area, cart barn, Pro Shop or any practice area.
- No golf course water coolers.
- No golf course beverage/food carts roaming.
- Each Player should be responsible to bringing their own beverage and energy bars.
- Scoring will be done just off the final green or in the closest shaded area by Coaches. No indoor scoring area.
- Physical scorecards will be verbally communicated with hole-by-hole scores to the Coaches as the fellow competitors hear aloud. At scoring each Player will announce his/her scores hole by hole aloud for any competitor to hear and disagree with before all have verbally agreed
- After leaving the scoring area, the hole-by-hole score is considered final.
